



Observations, Cameras and Photographs Policy

The Flower Cottage requires parents and carers to consent to photographs of your child being taken during the registration process. If parents and carers consent to this, they are also able to choose from a variety of situations when this is agreeable. This includes for use within electronic journals, photos for their written learning journeys (individual and group), displays within the setting and on The Flower Cottage' social media. Where permission is not provided, photographs will not be taken of your child and your child will be edited out of the picture.

Photographs of children will only be taken on devices that are registered with The Flower Cottage.

Please ensure you have read and understand the Observations, Cameras and Photographs policy and procedure.

All policies and procedures are reviewed regularly and updated when necessary.
